But their personal goals include pursuing a career that is more fulfilling and satisfying than what they are currently doing. Scholarship funds are often not available to these second-career students. The Trust created this scholarship program specifically for individuals like Edy, Dana and Alyssa. They are making a change in their career and, as such, will be change-makers in this profession."
